Liberals vow to "get assault weapons and handguns off our streets" despite Canada having the lowest rates of firearm related violence in decades.

Liberals introduce Bill C-71, aimed almost entirely at licensed guns owners including bringing back 2/3rds of the long gun registry.

The Liberals roll out a sweeping & historic gun ban in May 2020, justified by the spree shooting in Nova Scotia. The perpetrator smuggled all the firearms used, from the United States.

With crime almost entirely out of control, the Liberals respond by "freezing" the market on only legal handguns possessed and registered by



Liberals pass Bill C-21 legislating their handgun ban as well as prohibiting all new semi-autos with detachable magazines in the future.


